Question: *When using VCP, what computer keyboard keys are the equivalent of console or handset keys?*

Answer: *The desk console has three keys that do not appear on the handset or VCP handset image, but are available in VCP: F1, F2, F3. By default, F1 on the console (which is F6 in VCP) disables the console speaker (in VCP, the audio to the computer speaker). Other keys:*
